CHAPTER 10.

[Published February 1, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Chapter 236 of the General Laws of 1860, entitled "An act to organize the county of Door for judicial purposes."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two (2) of chapter 236 of the general laws of 1860, is hereby amended by striking out all of said section after the word "circuit," in the second line, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: And there shall be held two terms of the circuit court, in said county, at the county seat thereof, in each year: one term on the third Monday of February, and one term on the second Monday of July.

Two terms of court provided

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 11.

[Published February 6, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Chapter 874 of the General Laws of 1860, entitled "An act to authorize the Governor of the State of Wisconsin to seize certain land on Green Island, for the use of the State."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That section one of said act be and is hereby amended by striking out the words "south west,"
