

CHAPTER 110.

[Published March 22, 1862.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 216 of the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to amend chapter 184 of the revised statutes, entitled 'of inquest [inquests] of the dead, (in the county of Milwaukee.)'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and sixteen of ^{Repeal.} the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to amend chapter one hundred and eighty-four of the revised statutes, entitled 'of inquests of the dead,'" is hereby repealed, and all laws thereby repealed or suspended, are hereby restored and declared to be in full force.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
