CHAPTER 121.

[Published March 26, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of supervisors of Marathon county to audit and pay certain claims.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of the county of Marathon, are hereby authorized to audit and allow claims for services rendered in opening or working upon a certain road established, or intended to be established, in said county of Marathon, by the board of supervisors of said county, by an order adopted by said board, at their annual session held in November, 1861; said claims to be presented to said board and verified by affidavit, in the same manner as other claims against the county.

Authority to audit claims for opening certain road.

SECTION 2. When said claims shall have been audited and allowed as aforesaid, the board of supervisors of said county shall issue county orders in payment thereof; and such county orders shall, in all respects, be as valid and binding against said county of Marathon, as other county orders issued in payment of county indebtedness.

County orders to be issued in payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
