

CHAPTER 187.

[Published March 28, 1862.]

AN ACT to change the name of Bad Ax county to that of Vernon.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The name of Bad Ax county, in this Name changed. state, is hereby changed to Vernon county, and by this latter name the said county shall be called and known in popular nomenclature and in law, in all places and for all purposes; and wherever, in any law of this state, and in all deeds, mortgages and public records, the words "Bad Ax" occur, having reference to said county of Bad Ax, (now county of Vernon,) said words shall be construed and understood in the same manner as if the word "Vernon" were printed or written in lieu thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May, A. D. 1862.
