

CHAPTER 148.

[Published March 29, 1862.]

AN ACT to appropriate to A. P. Hodges, states [state] prison commissioner, a certain sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

For current expenses.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to A. P. Hodges, states [state] prison commissioner, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars, to defray the current expences [expenses] of the states [state] prison for the year 1862; the said fifteen thousand dollars to be drawn from the treasury quarterly in advance, to commence on the first day of January, 1862; and the said commissioner shall return a detailed account of his disbursements to the governor, at the end of each quarter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
