Watrous, joint standing committee on state prison, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, being payment in full for expenses incurred by said persons, in visiting the state prison at Waupun, as such committee, during the regular session of the legislature for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 166.

[Published April 1, 1862.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 201 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "an act to amend 'an act to regulate insurance companies not incorporated by the state of Wisconsin,' approved March 17th, 1859."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The first line of section five of chapter 190 of the general laws of 1859, is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "A sum of money equal to three per cent. upon." License fee.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act, and chapter 201 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "an act to amend 'an act to regulate insurance companies not incorporated by the state of Wisconsin,'" are hereby repealed. Repeal.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
