AN ACT to amend chapter 252 [of the] private and local laws of 1858, entitled "an act to amend an act to incorporate the city of La Crosse, approved March 14th, 1856," approved May 15th, 1858.

CHAPTER 206.

[Published April 8, 1862.]

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter 123 of the revised statutes, entitled "of the place of trial of civil actions."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Change of place
of trial.

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter one hundred and twenty-three of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows : "Whenever any party in any civil action pending in any court of record, shall apply to the court or the judge thereof, for a change of the place of trial of such action, on account of the prejudice of the judge of such court, and shall verify such application by his oath or affidavit, the court or the judge thereof shall change the place of trial of such action ; but no court commissioner or county judge acting as a court commissioner, shall be authorized to change the place of trial of any action. When such application is made to the judge, it shall be on notice, of not less than ten days, to the adverse party.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
