CHAPTER 366.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 381 of the general laws of 1862, entitled "an act to ascertain and settle the liabilities of the state of Wisconsin to the Milwaukee and Rock river canal company," approved April 8, 1862.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter 381 of the general laws of 1862, entitled "an act to ascertain and settle the liabilities of the state of Wisconsin to the Milwaukee and Rock river canal company," approved April 8, 1862, is hereby repealed. ^{Repeal.}

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
