CHAPTER 37.

[Published February 24, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the state superintendent of public instruction to apportion certain school money to the county of Marquette, for joint school district number three, of the towns of Newton and Crystal Lake.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Amount to be apportioned.

SECTION 1. The state superintendent of public instruction is hereby authorized and required to apportion for joint school district number three, of the towns of Newton and Crystal Lake, in the county of Marquette, the same amount and proportion of school money for the year 1862, that the said school district would be entitled to receive had the district clerk made the annual report as required by law: *provided*, that the report of said school district shall be now returned, duly authenticated, to the state superintendent.

Proviso.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
