

CHAPTER 70.

[Published March 10, 1862.]

AN ACT to change the time of holding the circuit court [courts] in certain counties of this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

- SECTION 1.** Hereafter the terms of the circuit court [courts] in and for the several counties hereinafter named, shall be held at the several times hereinafter mentioned, instead of the times now provided by law, viz. :
- Clark county.** In the county of Clark, on the first Monday of September and the third Monday of May, of each year.
- Jackson.** In the county of Jackson, on the second Monday of September and the second Monday of May, of each year.
- La Crosse.** In the county of LaCrosse, on the third Monday of September and the first Monday of April, in each year.
- Monroe.** In the county of Monroe, on the first Monday of October and the third Monday of April, of each year : *provided*, that the first April term shall be held in 1868, and shall not be construed as in any wise interfering with the spring term of 1862, as now provided by law.
- Bad Ax.** In the county of Bad Ax, on the second Monday of October and the fourth Monday of April, in each year.
- Crawford.** In the county of Crawford, on the third Monday of October and the fourth Monday of May of each year.
- Buffalo.** In the county of Buffalo, on the fourth Monday of October and the first Monday of May, of each year.
- Trempealeau.** In the county of Trempeleau [Trempealeau,] on the first Monday of November and the first Wednesday after the first Tuesday of April, of each year.
- Richland.** In the county of Richland, on the second Monday of November and the first Monday of June, of each year.
- SECTION 2.** All process, actions, proceedings or recognizances heretofore commenced, issued or taken in or from said courts, or either of them, and all proceedings pending therein or returnable thereto, whether by recognizances or otherwise, shall be held and taken as returnable at the times named in this act as the times for holding said courts respectively.
- SECTION 3.** All acts and parts of acts conflicting

with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 71.

[Published March 10, 1862.]

AN ACT to change the time for advertising lands for sale by county treasurers for delinquent taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Lands returned to county treasurers for delinquent taxes, as provided by law, shall not be advertised for sale by any county treasurer in this state, prior to the first Monday in April next after the return thereof.

Not to be advertised prior to first Monday of April.

SECTION 2. The delinquent taxes and charges returned on any such lands, may be paid to the county treasurer, as otherwise provided by law, at any time prior to said first Monday in April, without any charge or fee for advertising the same being made or preferred against the person paying such taxes.

No charge for advertising prior to said day.

SECTION 3. The secretary of state shall forthwith submit [transmit] by mail a printed copy of this act to each county treasurer in this state; and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Copies of act to be transmitted to county treasurers.
