

Chien, under and by virtue of an act of the legislature of the state of Wisconsin, entitled "an act to authorize the town of Prairie du Chien to aid in the construction of a bridge across the Wisconsin river," approved March 4th, 1857.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 83.

[Published March 10, 1862.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the sale of lands for unpaid taxes for the year 1861, in the city and county of La Crosse.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the sale of lands for unpaid taxes, interest and charges, for the year 1861, in the city and county of La Crosse, is hereby extended to the second Monday of September, A. D. 1862. ^{Extended to September 8th.}

SEC. 2. Previous [previously] to the day of sale appointed in this act, the treasurer of the county of La Crosse and the treasurer of the city of La Crosse, shall give like notice of such sale by advertizement [advertisement] as is now required by law for the sale of lands for unpaid taxes. ^{Notice of sale.}

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
