

CHAPTER 172.

[Published April 2, 1863.]

AN ACT to provide for the reletting of the contract for public printing.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioners of public printing, as provided in chapter 315 of the laws of 1860, may relet the contract for public printing, from the date of the passage of this act until the 31st day of December, 1864, being the unexpired term of the contract with Messrs. Carpenter & Hyer, at such notice as they may deem proper for the public interest, without advertising for six weeks, as now provided by law.

Authority to relet contract.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 173.

[Published April 16, 1863.]

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act changing the time of holding the terms of the circuit court of Chippewa, Eau Claire, Dunn and Pepin."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The circuit court in the following named counties, shall be holden at the times hereinafter mentioned, to wit: In the county of Pepin, on the first Monday of March and the first Monday of September, in each year; in the county of Dunn, on the second Monday of March and the second Monday of September, in each year; in the county of Eau Claire, on the third Monday of March and the third Monday of September, in each year; in the county of Chippewa, on the fourth Monday of March and the fourth Monday of September, of each year.
