

CHAPTER 310.

[Published March 5, 1863.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 170 of the private and local laws of the year 1854, entitled "an act to incorporate the Depere company," approved March 23, 1854.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The said Depere company is hereby authorized and empowered to grant, bargain, sell, lease or mortgage any of the real estate, water-powers, rights and privileges of said company; and any conveyance or mortgage thereof, signed by the president and attested by the secretary of said company, and sealed with its corporate seal, shall be valid, any by-law or ordinance of said company to the contrary notwithstanding.

May sell or mortgage real estate, &c.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT to amend section twelve of chapter one hundred of the private and local laws of 1862, entitled "an act to incorporate the Apple river boom company."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter one hundred of the private and local laws of 1862, entitled "an act to incorporate the Apple river boom company," is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "The said company shall be and is hereby authorized and empowered to construct, maintain and keep in repair a boom at and across the mouth of Apple river, and along the east side of the river St. Croix, between the south line of section one, in township thirty, north of range twenty

Company may construct boom, &c.
