

CHAPTER 187.

[Published March 31, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend section 38 of chapter 117 of the revised statutes, entitled "of county courts."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section 38 of chapter 117 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Section 38. Each county shall furnish the judge of the county court with all necessary blanks and stationery, and all books necessary for keeping the records of the county court."

Judge to be furnished with books and stationery.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 188.

[Published April 2, 1864.]

AN ACT to authorize school district number eight, in the town of Port Washington, in the county of Ozaukee, to borrow money.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. School district number eight, in the town of Port Washington, is hereby authorized to borrow such sum or sums of money, not to exceed two hundred dollars, at a rate of interest not to exceed seven per cent. (*per cent.*) per annum, upon such length of time as the board thereof may determine, and to renew such loan from time to time; and the officers are hereby authorized, in the name of said district, to make and execute any bond, pledge or security binding said district and the property thereof, that they may deem proper and advisable, to secure the payment of such money borrowed and the interest thereon.

District authorized to borrow \$200.

Bonds to secure same.

SECTION 2. Before any such loan as is provided for in this act shall be effected, the amount of such loan

shall be determined upon by a vote of the electors of said district, at an annual or special meeting thereof; and a special meeting for that purpose may be called in the manner now provided by law for calling special school district meetings.

Property of district liable.

SECTION 3. Should any such loan be effected by the board of said district, under the provisions of this act, all the taxable property of said district at the time of making the loan, and all that may hereafter be added or annexed thereto, shall be holden for the faithful payment of the interest and principal of the money loaned; and it shall be the duty of the clerk of said district, in addition to other taxes of said district, to add, without a vote of said district, a tax sufficient to pay the interest or principal due, according to the conditions of said loan.

Tax for interest and principal.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 189.

[Published April 2, 1864.]

AN ACT to change the time of holding the annual school meeting in school district number one, of the village of Elkhorn, Walworth county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

To be held second Tuesday of July.

SECTION 1. The annual school meeting in and for school district number one, of the village of Elkhorn, shall hereafter be held on the second Monday of July, in each year. The hour of such meeting shall be seven o'clock in the afternoon, unless otherwise provided by a vote of the district, duly recorded, at the last annual meeting.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
