CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 209 of the private and local laws of the year (A. D.) 1859, entitled "an act to vacate a portion of A. M. Thomson's addition to the village of Hartford, in the county of Washington."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and nine of the private and local laws of the year (A. D.) 1859, entitled "an act to vacate a portion of A. M. Thomson's addition to the village of Hartford, in the county of Washington," is hereby repealed.

Addition revived

SECTION 2. Thomson's addition to the village of Hartford, mentioned in section one of this act, as the same was originally surveyed, platted and recorded, is hereby revived and restored, according to the recorded plat thereof, to the same extent and with like force and effect as if said chapter 209 of the private and local laws of 1859 had not been passed: *provided, however*, that such restoration shall in no wise affect or impair any assessment thereof heretofore made, nor any tax heretofore levied on the lands embraced in said plat, or any lot, parcel or tract thereof.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
