

ing words: "And the fees for the publication of any notice of sale of lands for taxes, and of the time when redemption of lands sold for taxes will expire, in a newspaper published in any other than the English language, shall be apportioned upon the several parcels of land advertised: *provided*, such publication is ordered and made in accordance with the provisions of section fifty-one of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes; and all costs, charges and interest hereby imposed and paid upon any lands, shall be a lien thereon until paid, equally with the unpaid taxes."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 210.

[Published April 6, 1864.]

AN ACT to set off certain lands from the city of Prescott, and attach the same to the town of Clifton, in Pierce county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Description of
lands.

SECTION 1. The southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section number two, and the south half of the southeast quarter of section number three, in township number twenty-six, of range twenty, are hereby set off from the city of Prescott, and the same are hereby attached to and made a part of the town of Clifton, in the county of Pierce.

Repeal.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts interfering with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
