

## CHAPTER 279.

[Published April 19, 1864.]

AN ACT to authorize Fordyce S. Richards to keep and maintain a ferry on the Mississippi river.

## CHAPTER 280.

[Published April 18, 1864.]

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and two, one hundred and three, one hundred and four and one hundred and five of chapter twenty-three of the revised statutes, relating to common schools.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Sections one hundred and two, one hundred and three, one hundred and four and one hundred and five of chapter twenty-three of the revised statutes, entitled "of common schools," are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 281.

AN ACT for the relief of Portage county.
