

**SECTION 2.** No notice of the holding of said special terms shall be required other than the passage and publication of this act. No other notice required.

**SECTION 3.** Section 2 of chapter 368 of the general laws of 1862, is hereby repealed. Repeal.

**SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

**CHAPTER 33.**

[*Published February 15, 1864.*]

**AN ACT** to authorize the town of Milford, in Jefferson county, to levy and collect a special tax to pay bounties to volunteers, and to define certain boundaries of said town.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

**SECTION 1.** The town of Milford, in the county of Jefferson, is hereby authorized and empowered to levy and collect a tax for the purpose of paying bounties to volunteers: *provided*, the amount of such tax shall have been first specified by vote of a special town meeting held pursuant to law in said town for that purpose. Tax authorized.

**SECTION 2.** Sections one, two, three, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen and fifteen, of township number eight, north of range fourteen east, having been by chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the general laws of 1863, detached from said town, shall not be held to constitute a part of said town of Milford for any purpose whatever. Detached.

**SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
