CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Springfield, in Dane county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of the state, county and town taxes, for the year 1864, [1863,] in the town of Springfield, in Dane county, is hereby extended until the twentieth day of March, 1864; and the town treasurer of said town shall have the same right to proceed to collect all the unpaid taxes upon the tax roll in his hands, in all respects, in the same manner as he would have been authorized to do had the time specified in his original warrant for the return thereof, not expired: *provided*, nothing in this act shall be construed to extend the time for the payment to the county treasurer [of] the state tax of said town, as now required by law.
