

CHAPTER 81.

[Published February 26, 1864.]

AN ACT to authorize the assessor of the town of Hartford, in the county of Washington, to correct the assessment roll of that town.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Authority to correct assessment roll.

SECTION 1. The assessor of the town of Hartford, in the county of Washington, for the year 1863, is authorized and directed to correct the assessment roll of his town in regard to the valuation of real estate, where mistakes have been made in extending and copying the amount of the valuation of such real estate, or where the valuation of such real estate as now entered upon such assessment roll, is manifestly erroneous, and not proportionate to the real value of such real estate; and such assessment roll so corrected shall be as valid and legal for all purposes of taxation, as it would have been had the valuations been originally entered as corrected.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the city of Racine.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Extended to March 28.

SECTION 1. The time for the collection and return of the state and county taxes in the city of Racine, Racine county, is hereby extended until the twenty-eighth day of March, A. D. 1864, and the tax warrant now in the hands of the city treasurer shall be in full force until the said twenty-eighth day of March, A. D.
