## CHAPTER 276.

[Published May 19, 1865.]

AN ACT to authorize the state superintendent of public instruction to apportion school moneys to the town of Randolph, Columbia county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The state superintendent of public instruction is hereby authorized and directed to apportion to the town of Randolph, in the county of Columbia, the full amount of school moneys to which said town would have been entitled for the present year, if the report of the clerk of the joint district number two (2) of said town for the year 1864, had been made at the time prescribed by law; and the town clerk of said town is hereby directed to apportion to said joint district its full share of all school moneys coming into the hands of the town treasurer for the present year, the same as if the report of the clerk of said district for 1864, had been received by him within the time prescribed by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
