

## CHAPTER 277.

[Published April 19, 1865.]

**AN ACT** to vacate Webster, Ford and Miller's addition to the city of Beaver Dam.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

**SECTION 1.** All the addition to the city of Beaver <sup>vacated.</sup> Dam, in the county of Dodge, known, described and recorded as Webster, Ford and Miller's addition to Beaver Dam, is hereby vacated, and shall be designated hereafter as outlot No. (71) seventy-one, of the third (3d) ward of the city of Beaver Dam.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
