

CHAPTER 814.

[Published May 22, 1865.]

AN ACT to change the name of the town of Hudson, in Walworth county, to that of Lyons.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The name of the town of Hudson, in Name changed. Walworth county, is hereby changed to that of Lyons.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 815.

[Published May 20, 1865.]

AN ACT to amend an act limiting the powers of the common council of the city of Hudson, approved April 6th, 1861.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of May issue orders for bridge purposes. Hudson are hereby authorized and empowered, for the purpose of aiding in building a bridge across Willow river at or near its mouth, to issue orders or certificates of indebtedness, to an amount not exceeding thirty-five hundred dollars, and deliver the same to the contractor who builds the same, and shall have power to provide for the redemption thereof by tax upon the taxable property of said city, as in other cases.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent Repeal. with this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
