CHAPTER 405.

[Published May 27, 1865.]

AN ACT to provide for the indexing and transcribing the journals of the senate and assembly.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation to
F. M. Stewart.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Frank M. Stewart, chief clerk of the senate, for indexing the senate journal, the sum of one hundred dollars, and for completing the transcribing of the senate journal, the sum of one hundred dollars.

Appropriation to
J. S. Dean.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to John S. Dean, chief clerk of the assembly, for indexing the assembly journal, the sum of one hundred dollars, and for completing the transcribing of the assembly journal, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars.

When money to
be drawn.

SECTION 3. No money hereby appropriated shall be drawn from the treasury until the secretary of state shall certify that the duties herein provided for shall have been respectively performed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
