

fer to such purchaser the interest or shares so sold, upon the books of such bank or company, or otherwise, as may be in accordance with [the] rules or by-laws of such bank or company.”

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 460.

[Published May 31, 1865.]

AN ACT relating to a tract index in Dodge county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Index of real estate records,

Fees.

SECTION 1. The register of deeds of Dodge county, and his successors in office, shall index all records of instruments affecting the title to real estate in said county, in accordance with the form of the books provided and now in use for that purpose; and the said register and his successors shall receive for such services heretofore or hereafter rendered, the same compensation that they would be entitled to receive for indexing said records in accordance with chapter 852 of the general laws of 1864, and no more.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect when published.
