## CHAPTER 496.

[Published May 31, 1865.]

AN ACT to legalize a special election to vote bounties to volunteers, held in the town of Sullivan, county of Jefferson, on the 22d February, 1865.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Bounty tax proceedings legalized.

SECTION 1. All the proceedings had prior to and at a special election, held in the town of Sullivan, Jefferson county, on the 22d day of February, 1865, for the purpose of voting a tax in said town to pay bounties to volunteers, are hereby declared to be as valid and binding upon said town, as though said meeting had been held upon some other day, and the forms of law had been fully complied with in calling and conducting the same. Nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to authorize the payment of more than two hundred dollars to any volunteer, or person providing himself with a substitute.

Limit to bounty.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
