AN ACT to legalize the election of town officers in Bovina, Outagamie county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The election of town officers of the town of Bovina, Outagamie county, held April 4th, 1865, is hereby legalized, and declared of full force and effect, notwithstanding the supervisors acting as inspectors of said election, were not sworn as such inspectors. Legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
