

meeting or out of it, shall be punished by fine not exceeding twenty dollars, nor less than five dollars.”

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 146.

[Published April 28, 1866.]

AN ACT to annex certain territory in the county of Ashland to the county of La Pointe, and to change the name of the county of La Pointe to that of Bayfield.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. All the territory now in the county of Ashland, known and described as townships forty-eight (48) and forty-nine (49,) of range (5) five west, and all of the fractional parts of townships forty-eight (48) and forty-nine (49,) of range four (4) west, situated on the west side of Long Island bay, are hereby detached from the county of Ashland, and annexed to the county of La Pointe.

Part of Ashland county annexed to La Pointe county.

SECTION 2. The name of the said county of La Pointe is hereby changed to that of Bayfield, and the said county of La Pointe shall hereafter be known and designated as the county of Bayfield.

Name of La Pointe county changed to that of Bayfield.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.
