

CHAPTER 120.

[Published April 17, 1867.]

AN ACT to authorize the school land commissioners to issue a patent for an acre and one-half of land therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The school land commissioners are hereby authorized and instructed to issue a patent to the Charlestown cemetery association, of Calumet county, for an acre and one-half of land lying in the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section sixteen (16,) in township eighteen (18) north, of range twenty (20) east, and now vesting with other lands in school land certificate No. 262, which said certificate is owned by Henry Modlin, of Calumet county: *provided*, that the said Henry Modlin or his assigns executes to the state a complete and entire renunciation of his rights and interests in the said lands in favor of and for the benefit of the said cemetery association.

Issue of patent authorized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 121.

[Published April 17, 1867.]

AN ACT for the protection of owners of land upon which the state has a lien, and of persons liable to the state upon loans from the trust funds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. In all cases where money is or may become due the state on account of land sold by the commissioners of school and university lands, or on account of any money loaned from any of the trust funds, the payment of which is secured by mortgage

Immediate payment may be required of moneys due the state.
