

thousand dollars, and for salary of the librarian of said society, fourteen hundred dollars.”

SECTION 2. This act shall be amendatory to section 2 of chapter 327 of the general laws of 1860, so far as the increased appropriation shall increase the responsibility of the society as the trustee of the state. Amendment.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after April 1st, 1867.

## CHAPTER 143.

[Published April 19, 1867.]

AN ACT to provide for the time of holding the meetings of the trustees of the state hospital for the insane.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The board of trustees of the Wisconsin state hospital for the insane, shall meet annually on the second Tuesday in October, which shall be styled the “annual meeting.” They shall also meet annually on the first Tuesday in May, which shall be styled the “semi-annual meeting.” Annual meetings.

SECTION 2. All provisions of an act entitled “an act to provide for the government of the Wisconsin state hospital for the insane,” approved March 30th, 1860, inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
