county, shall be deemed to be made or taken to the terms of such court, as the same are fixed by this act; and all motions or other proceedings noticed to be heard at any regular term of such court, shall be allowed and considered to be noticed for hearing at the regular terms of such court, as the same are fixed by this act.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with

the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT to cede jurisdiction to the United States of America over lands to be occupied as sites of light-house buildings in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Jurisdiction of lands for lighthouse purposes ceded to U.S.

Descriptions.

8.

Service of process.

Section 1. The jurisdiction of this state is hereby ceded to the United States of America, over all such pieces or parcels of land, not exceeding eighty acres in any one parcel, as shall be hereafter required and selected by the United States for the purpose of erecting light-house buildings thereon: provided, that an accurate description and plats of such parcels of land to be so selected, with a statement of such selection by the United States, shall be filed by the United States with the governor of this state; and provided, further, that this cesssion is upon the express condition that the state of Wisconsin shall so far retain a concurrent jurisdiction with the United States in and over the tracts of land aforesaid, that all civil and criminal process issued under the authority of this state, or any officer thereof, may be executed on said land and in the buildings that may be erected thereon, in the same way and manner as if jurisdiction had not been ceded as aforesaid.

Section 2. The lands aforesaid when so ceded, Exemption shall forever be exempt from all taxes and assessments, so long as the same shall remain the property of the United States.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT to amend chapter 537 of the general laws of 1865, entitled "an act to dispose of the swamp and overflowed lands, and the proceeds therefrom."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 537 of the general laws of 1865, amended. entitled "an act to dispose of the swamp and overflowed lands, and the proceeds therefrom," is hereby amended, by inserting after the word "acre," in the last line of section 19, the words "excepting in the counties of Juneau and Wood, in which counties the commissioners are authorized to continue the reduction until the price reaches fifty cents per acre."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
