CHAPTER 7.

[Published February 23, 1867.]

AN ACT to amend section 25 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, entitled "of highways, bridges and ferries."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 25 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by striking out the words "excepting persons of color," where they occur in said section, so that the first subdivision of said section shall read as follows: "1. Every male inhabitant in each road district, being over the age of twenty-one years, and under the age of fifty years, excepting paupers, idiots and lunatics, shall be assessed to pay a poll-tax of one dollar. Said tax may be paid to the overseer in cash, or be commuted for in labor, as now provided for by law." Amendment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
