

## CHAPTER 135.

[Published March 13, 1868.]

AN ACT relating to and amendatory of section sixty of chapter eighteen of the revised statutes, entitled "of the assessment and collection of taxes."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section sixty of chapter eighteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "second" in the fourth line of said section and amending (of) it so as to read as follows: "The said town clerk shall immediately make out a fair copy of such assessment roll when thus completed, and deliver the same to the town treasurer of his town, on or before the third Monday of December in each year, but in no case shall the assessment roll be delivered to such treasurer until he shall have executed the bond and delivered the receipt required in the fifty-seventh and fifty-eighth section of this chapter." Amended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 136.

[Published March 14, 1868.]

AN ACT to provide for the re-assessment and collection of delinquent taxes of 1865 and 1866, on the shares of national banks in this state.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the state treasurer to transmit, as soon as practicable, to the assessor of every city, ward or town in this state, in which is located any banking association organized under a law of the United States, a statement prepared from the Delinquent bank tax must be re-assessed.
