

CHAPTER 138.

[Published March 13, 1868.]

AN ACT to amend section 33 of chapter 13, of the revised statutes, entitled "of counties and county officers "

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 13, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following proviso, to wit: "*provided further*, that no town containing an area of six miles square or less shall be divided, unless a majority of the legal voters of each subdivision of said town shall vote in favor of said division." Amended.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 139.

[Published March 13, 1868.]

AN ACT to establish the place of trial in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever a person holding the office of judge of the circuit court shall be a party to an action in the circuit court, or shall be near of kin to either party, such action may be instituted in any county of an adjoining circuit in this state, and like proceedings shall be had as if the parties defendant or any of them resident [resided] in such county. May bring action in adjoining county when judge is a party.

SECTION 2. All acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
