

companies not incorporated by the state of Wisconsin," is hereby amended by inserting after the words "official state paper," in the fifteenth line of the printed section three (3) of said law, the words "and one daily paper of general circulation published in the city of Milwaukee."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 19.

[*Published February 18, 1868.*]

AN ACT to amend section three (3) of chapter eighty-five (85,) of the laws of 1867, entitled "an act relating to the return and canvass of votes."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section three (3) of chapter eighty-five (85,) of the laws of 1867, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "and any town, ward, or election district causing the necessity of sending out such messenger, shall defray all the expense incurred thereby, and shall be charged therefor by the county board of supervisors."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
