

SECTION 2. Section two of chapter 160 of the general laws of 1859, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "and in the computation of interest upon any bond, note or other instrument or agreement, interest shall not be compounded, nor shall the interest thereon be construed to bear interest." Amended.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT to amend subdivision 2 of section 1 and to repeal subdivision 3 of section 1 of chapter 92 of the revised statutes, entitled "of real property by descent"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision 2 of section 1 of chapter 92 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "If he shall leave no issue, his estate, real and personal, shall descend to his widow; and if he shall leave no issue or widow, his estate shall descend to his father." Amended.

SECTION 2. Subdivision 3 of section 1 of chapter 92 of the revised statutes, and all laws conflicting with the provisions of said section 1 as amended, are hereby repealed. Ibid.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
