

CHAPTER 110.

[Published March 16, 1869.]

AN ACT in relation to time of apportionment of state and county taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 130 of the general laws of 1868, entitled "an act to provide for the assessment of property for taxation, and the levy of taxes thereon," is hereby amended by striking out the words, "fifteenth day of May" where they occur in said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "the tenth day of October."

Time when tax shall be apportioned changed.

SECTION 2. Section 10 of said chapter 130 of the general laws of 1868 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 10. The board of supervisors shall at their annual meeting in November, determine by resolution the amount of tax to be levied in their county for county purposes for the year, and also the amount to be raised by tax in each town for the support of common schools therein for the ensuing year, which shall not in any town be less than the amount apportioned to such town in the last apportionment of the income of the school fund.

When supervisors shall determine amount of assessment.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
