

CHAPTER 133.

[Published March 17, 1869.]

AN ACT to fix the compensation of members of the board of supervisors of Fond du Lac county, in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Compensation
fixed.

SECTION 1. The members of the board of supervisors of the county of Fond du Lac shall each receive three dollars per day for each and every day they shall be employed on the session of the board, and six cents per mile for going to and returning from the place of holding such session; but no supervisor shall be allowed to draw pay for more than twenty-five days' attendance on the county board in one year.

Repealed.

SECTION 2. Section 10 of chapter 129 of the general laws of 1861, section 49 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, and all acts or parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act so far as the county of Fond du Lac is concerned, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 134.

AN ACT to authorize the counties and towns through which the Winnebago, Waupaca and Mississippi railroad may pass, to aid in its construction.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Counties and
towns may aid
railroad by issue
of bonds.

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for any county through any portion of which any part of the Winnebago, Waupaca and Mississippi railway shall run
