

and may fill any vacancy caused by such removal, or from any other cause.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 15.

[Published February 25, 1869.]

AN ACT fixing the time of holding terms of courts of record when the same shall happen on a legal holiday.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever it shall happen that the time fixed by law for the holding of any term of a court of record shall be upon a legal holiday, the clerk of said court or the judge thereof, shall open and adjourn the same until the next day. Clerk or judge to adjourn court for holiday.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT to amend chapter 130 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to amend the second sub-division of section 25 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, entitled of highways and bridges."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and thirty of the general laws of 1867, is hereby Amended.
