

## CHAPTER 158.

[Published March 23, 1869.]

AN ACT to exempt the real estate of the home of the friendless from taxation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The real estate of the home of the friendless, owned and occupied by said company in the city of Milwaukee, not exceeding one lot in amount, is hereby exempted from taxation so long as the same shall continue to be used as such home. Exempted.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 159.

[Published March 23, 1869.]

AN ACT in regard to supervisors of the county of Burnett.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The election of the county board of supervisors of the county of Burnett, at the general election in November last, of which board Canute Anderson is acting as chairman, is hereby legalized and declared to be of full binding force and effect, and all the acts of said board so far as the illegality of its election may affect the same are hereby declared to be valid and are hereby legalized. Legalized.

SECTION 2. The said board of supervisors shall hold office, one for one year, one for two years and one for three years from the first day of January, A. D. 1869, or until their successors shall be duly elected and Term of office of supervisors.
