

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT to change the name of the county of Dallas to that of Barron.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The name of the county of Dallas in Name changed. the state of Wisconsin, is hereby changed to that of Barron, and by the name of Barron it shall hereafter be known and designated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 76.

[Published March 22, 1869.]

AN ACT relating to the county court of Trempealeau county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The county judge of the county of Trempealeau is hereby authorized to keep his office Where county judge may keep his office. and to transact any and all probate business and to hold terms of the county court at the village of Trempealeau, and all business done and transacted and all lawful judgments, orders and decrees made by the said judge or court shall be as valid and binding in all respects, as if such courts had been held and such business had been done at the county seat of said county.

SECTION 2. All lawful orders, judgments and decrees heretofore made, and all business heretofore done and transacted by the county judge or county court of Trempealeau county, are hereby legalized and declared All orders, etc. legalized.
