

CHAPTER 182.

[Published March 24, 1870.]

AN ACT to authorize the secretary of state to audit certain accounts and to appropriate money for the payment thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

May audit
accounts.

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to audit the account of the postmaster of the city of Madison for newspapers received by the members of the legislature.

Appropriation.

SECTION 2. There is hereby annually appropriated a sum of money sufficient to pay the said account as provided in this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 183.

[Published March 28, 1870.]

AN ACT relating to homesteads and amendatory of section 1, chapter 145, revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 145 of the revised statutes, entitled "of actions for the foreclosure of a mortgage," is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: "and if any portion of the mortgaged premises shall consist of a homestead, it shall be the duty of the court in such manner as it shall direct, to ascertain whether the part of said mortgaged premises not included in the homestead can be sold separately without injury to the owner, and if the
