

CHAPTER, 146.

AN ACT to amend section 2, chapter 40 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to encourage the cultivation of cranberries."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter forty of the general laws of 1867, is hereby amended by striking out from the third and fourth lines, the words, "below said marsh lands," and inserting after the word, "draining" in the fifth line, the words, "watering and flooding," and inserting after the word, "from" in the sixth line the words, "or bringing it on to," so that the entire section when thus amended, shall read as follows: Section 2. It shall also be lawful for any such person or persons to dig, construct and keep open, upon, across and through any lands, all such drains and ditches as shall be or become necessary for the purpose of draining, watering or flooding and carrying off the water from or bringing it on to such marsh land, wherever it shall be desirable so to do. Amended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
