

## CHAPTER 42.

[Published March 14, 1870.]

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 8 of the general laws of 1868, entitled "an act to amend section 1 of chapter 123 of the general laws of 1865, entitled 'an act relating to the terms of the circuit court of the fifth judicial circuit, and amendatory of chapter 15 of the general laws of 1865.'"

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter six of the general laws of 1868, entitled "an act to amend section one of chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the general laws of 1865, entitled 'an act relating to the terms of the circuit court of the fifth judicial circuit, and amendatory of chapter fifteen of the general laws of 1865,'" is hereby amended by striking out the words, "on the fourth Monday in April," after the word, "La Fayette," in the twelfth line of said section, and inserting instead thereof the words, "on the fourth Monday in June," so that hereafter the general and special terms of the circuit court of the fifth judicial circuit shall be held as follows: in the county of Grant, on the first Monday in March and second Monday in September of each year. In the county of Iowa, on the fourth Monday in March and first Monday in October of each year. In the county of La Fayette, on the fourth Monday in June and the first Monday in December. In the county of Richland, on the second Monday in April and the fourth Monday in October, and in the county of Crawford, on the first Monday in June and the second Monday in November of each year, as aforesaid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
