

CHAPTER 46.

[Published March 14, 1870.]

AN ACT to provide and appropriate compensation to the officers of the legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient to pay the per diem of officers of the legislature as follows: to the chief clerks, each six dollars; to the assistant clerks, book keepers and sergeant-at-arms each, five dollars; to all other clerks, clerks of standing committees, assistant sergeant-at-arms and postmasters each, four dollars; to the assistant postmasters, door keepers, firemen, porters, gallery attendants and night watchmen each, three dollars and fifty cents; to all messengers each, two dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall apply to the whole time of the present session of the legislature.

SECTION 3. Chapter 58 of the general laws of 1868 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
