

# GENERAL LAWS.

## CHAPTER 1.

[Published January 14, 1871.]

AN ACT to legalize an adjourned term of the circuit court in and for the county of Rock.

### PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS, The judge of the first judicial circuit ad- Preamble.  
journed the November term of the circuit court appointed to be held in and for the county of Rock from the 24th (twenty-fourth) day of December, A. D. 1870, and to the 16th day of January, 1871, and

WHEREAS, The said county of Rock, by operation of law has since become a part of the twelfth judicial circuit, therefore

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The adjourned term of the circuit court Legalized.  
in the twelfth judicial circuit, appointed to be held in and for the county of Rock on the 16th (sixteenth) day of January, A. D. 1871, is hereby legalized and made valid, and all motions, orders, judgments or other proceedings made or had at said adjourned term shall have the same force and effect as though the judge of the first judicial circuit had had full power and authority to adjourn the November term of the first judicial circuit appointed to be held in and for said county of Rock, to said 16th (sixteenth) day of January, A. D. 1871, and said adjournment so made by said judge is in all things hereby legalized and made valid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
