

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 110 of the general laws of 1868, entitled "an act requiring reports from unorganized banks and bankers."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 110 of the general laws of 1868 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Every person, association of persons and body corporate, engaged in the business of banking, buying and selling exchange and receiving deposits, except such bodies corporate as are expressly authorized by the state or national banking law, shall report semi-annually in writing to the bank controller or to such state officer as banks organized under the general banking law of this state are now or may be required hereafter to render their reports; such report to be verified by the affidavit of such person or any member of such association or corporation, and to contain the total amount due depositors, the amount of funds on hand, the names of the person or persons interested in or carrying on said business, the total amount of the capital stock employed in said business, and such other items, so far as practicable, as bankers under the state banking laws are required to report.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
