

CHAPTER 90.

[Published April 4, 1872.]

AN ACT to repeal sections seventy, seventy-one and ninety-seven of chapter 152 of the general laws of 1869, entitled "an act to codify the laws of this state relating to highways and bridges," and to amend section ninety-one of the same act.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections seventy and seventy-one and ninety-seven of chapter 152 of the general laws of 1869, entitled "an act to codify the laws of this state relating to highways and bridges," are hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. Section ninety-one of said chapter 152, general laws of 1869, is amended so as to read as follows: Whenever any road specified in the preceding sections shall be altered as therein provided, any person considering himself aggrieved by such alteration may appeal from the decision of such county board of supervisors within thirty days thereafter, and apply to the county judge of said county for the appointment of three commissioners, to whom the appeal from such determination of said board of supervisors may be taken. The said appeal shall be made in the same manner and bond given and the same proceedings had as provided in sections seventy-eight, seventy-nine, eighty, eighty-one and eighty-two of said chapter 152 of the general laws of 1869, so far as the same are applicable, only that the county judge shall act in the appointment of commissioners and issuing warrant, instead of a justice of the peace. Amended.
May appeal
from decision.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
