CHAPTER 77.

[Published March 4, 1873.]

AN ACT to prevent the use of imperfect copies of papers in legal actions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any officer whose duty it may be to make and certify or serve any copy of any paper, process, pleading or notice, in any legal action, to make such copy by a letter press imprint upon thin or tissue paper, or to certify or serve any such copy. And the service of any such copy, in any action or proceeding, by any officer, party or attorney, shall be held invalid, illegal and of no effect. Service of letter press copies illegal.

CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT to amend sections seventeen and eighteen of chapter one hundred and thirty of the general laws of 1868, entitled "an act to provide for the assessment of property for taxation, and the levy of taxes thereon."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty of the general laws of 1868, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 17.
