

## CHAPTER 131.

AN ACT to appropriate to S. V. Shipman a certain sum of money.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of <sup>Appropriated.</sup> any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of twenty-six and 20-100 (\$26.20) to S. V. Shipman for expenses incurred in appearing as a witness before the joint committee on claims.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 132.

[*Published March 21, 1874.*]

AN ACT to authorize the county board of supervisors of Milwaukee county to procure an abstract of tax sales.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of Milwaukee county is hereby authorized, whenever in its judgment <sup>Abstract of tax sales.</sup> the public interest may require it, to contract with the county clerk of said county for making and keeping up an abstract of tax sales of said county, on such terms and in such manner as the said county board of supervisors, by resolution, may prescribe.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
